Dear Parents,

We know we have sent much information in the last few days. We appreciate your attention to all of the matters presented to you.

Morning temperature checks and arrival: Parents are asked to please take a child's temperature at home before arrival. Upon arrival at school, staff are scanning students' foreheads to check temperatures. As stated in our reopening plan a student with a temperature of 100.4 and over will be sent home. Please be aware that temperatures of 99.0 – 100.3 may result in a child being sent home at the discretion of Mrs. Potenza. We will err on the side of caution and appreciate your understanding. Students with temperatures that scan between 99.0-100.3, after 3 attempts in the arrival line, may sit in the parking lot with parents for 10 minutes and then return to the line for a repeat scan. Students are asked to wear the lanyards that were in their packet for arrival and while in school.

Change of address, email or phone numbers: Please inform the school office of any change in information.

Lunch: Please send lunches that a student can open on their own. No assistance can be offered during lunch. We are still waiting for Hot Lunch ordering for September to open. We will notify you when this occurs. August hot lunch service begins Monday, August 24 for those families that ordered.

EDP: Students attending EDP may bring a small Ziploc bag with toys or items to play with during EDP. These items cannot be shared with other students and is the sole responsibility of the student. St. Zachary is not responsible for loss of items.
