Dear Parents,

- **Home Language Survey:** Is included in the attachment to today's email. Please complete and return to the school office either by email or drop off in the white mailbox located at the school entrance.
- **Free Hot Lunch for all students:** Yesterday we sent an email informing families that until 12/31/20 all students are entitled to receive free lunch. A copy of that letter is attached to today's email. Please send all responses to fsp@saintzachary.org, not to Saint Zachary School Office.
- **Peanut Butter:** Based on the medical conditions responses we have received students may now resume bringing peanut butter for lunch and snacks. If you have not notified us of a peanut allergy for your student, please do so.
- **Uniform:** While we understand that some uniform pieces may be on back order with our uniform company, students must be in appropriate school attire. If unable to wear an official uniform students should be in navy walking shorts with a green or white polo - our warm weather uniform. On gym days if no gym uniform is available students should be in navy gym type shorts and a solid grey t-shirt. Solid navy crew neck sweatshirts are permitted. Just a reminder of updated uniform policy – some things regarding the school uniform have been updated from the school handbook section which is attached to this email:
 - **Uniforms:** Solid color navy blue gym shorts or sweatpants may be worn. Sweatshirts may also be solid navy blue. **Logo is no longer mandatory for these items – only the gym t-shirt.** Leggings: May be either solid navy, black or white. Full length, no capris style. Solid navy cardigans and solid color navy crew neck sweatshirts may be worn as part of students' regular uniform. No other color sweatshirts may be worn during the school day. Hoodies are not allowed. **Shoes:** May be one predominant color. They do not need to be only white or black.
 - **Girls:** Effective immediately, girls in grades K-8 may wear full length, **navy uniform pants** with a white or green polo shirt. Please note: No leggings, jeans, jeggings, cargo or any style pants other than navy uniform style pants may be worn. Old Navy, Lands' End, Gap and Target sell uniform pants for girls. Dennis uniform also carries this type of uniform pant in their basic collection.
- **Weather:** Students will continue to go outside for gym, mask breaks, recess and outdoor learning. Please be sure your child is dressed for the weather.
- **Masks:** Thank you to those who are wearing masks at drop off as per St. Zachary policy. **Please note: Staff will no longer approach a car if both parent and students are not wearing a mask when arriving for morning wellness checks.**
- **Dismissal:** Students may not re-enter the building after dismissal to retrieve forgotten books, Chromebooks or other items left in their locker or classroom.
